

## Entertainment Guidelines

---

Please review the following guidelines that all performers must abide by while involved in live performances in downtown Sacramento:

- ✓ If performers are feeling sick or have come into close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, please stay at home.
- ✓ Performers must maintain 6' distance from each other & 12' from the public utilizing temporary (tape on the ground, tent, stations, planters, etc.) barriers, or delineations.
- ✓ Performers must wear face masks at all times, if able. Vocalists must maintain at least 12' from fellow performers & onlookers.
- ✓ Hand washing/hand sanitizing solutions must be used before, during and after performances.
- ✓ Performers are encouraged to post a nearby sign sharing Venmo account for tips vs. receiving cash tips.
- ✓ Ambient/acoustic entertainment preferred, preventing guests from raising their voice to speak over the music.
- ✓ Outdoor amplified sound is permitted by [city code](#) between the hours of 9 a.m. and 10 p.m. only; not to exceed 150 feet from music source.
- ✓ Ensure that sound equipment noise level is not so loud as to disturb nearby residents or businesses and does not violate the City of Sacramento Noise Ordinance.
- ✓ If any complaints (noise or otherwise) are received, the Sacramento Police Department and/or the City's Code Enforcement Officers will contact the performer to request that they turn the music down or completely off, regardless of the time.
- ✓ All performers must purchase a one-day entertainment insurance policy, and add "Downtown Sacramento Partnership, 980 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 200, Sacramento, CA 95814" as additionally insured on the insurance policy. You can easily obtain this through [thimble.com](https://www.thimble.com) for about \$50. If you plan to sign up to perform more than one day in a 30-day period, we suggest getting the monthly policy to save costs. All performers will receive a stipend to cover event fees, permits, etc.
